Art historian and curator, from 2002 to 2008 Medina was associate curator of Latin American Art at the Tate Modern in London. In 2009 he curated Teresa Margolles' project for the Mexican pavilion at the Venice Biennale, and he is curatorial director of Manifesta 9, the art biennial that will be held this year in Genk (Limburg, Belgium).
